



The School For Excellence Master Class Programs Code of Conduct

To ensure the comfort and safety of all visitors to our centre, and out of respect for the Elizabeth Blackburn School of Sciences campus, students participating in The School For Excellence tuition programs are required to adhere to the following Conduct Policy.

Rules: It is a condition of enrolment that students follow the following rules:

1. Students are allowed to eat food in the breakout areas, **but not** in the classrooms or theatres. Students are allowed to bring a bottle of water only into the classrooms.
2. Smoking anywhere in the building is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**.
3. Smoking in the outside entry foyer, the outside stairs leading to the building and/or immediately in front of the building is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**.
4. Students will behave respectfully in the common areas.
5. Students must stay aware of noise levels and use appropriate language when moving through, in and out of the building.
6. Students must show courtesy and respect to the other students and teachers using the building.
7. Students will keep the facilities in a clean and tidy condition. Rubbish is to be thrown in the bins provided throughout the building.
8. Students agree to keep the toilets and lounges in a **CLEAN and hygienic condition at all times**. Please notify Reception of any mess or disorder as soon as possible.
9. Students found to be causing willful damage will be required to pay for replacement/repair of damaged items and will forfeit their enrolment in the Master Classes.
10. Only those students enrolled in the Master Classes are permitted to partake in these programs and/or participate in the actual classes.
11. Students can only attend the classes that they are permanently allocated to, unless they have permission from Administration to attend another class. Your teacher cannot give you permission to attend their class.

Failure to follow the Code of Conduct could result in the termination of your enrolment in the Master Classes. Should this occur before the end of the course, no refunds will be issued for classes missed.
