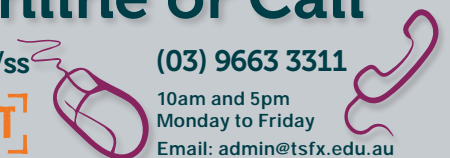

## Unit 3 English Text Analysis Lectures

(Total = 2 Hours per Text)

The text analysis lectures will focus on the **analytical interpretation** of the text you will be studying at school during Term 1 – 2024. These lectures will **NOT** cover the features, conventions & organisational structures involved in writing an analytical text response essay. These important topics will be addressed in Parts 1, 2 & 3 of the Unit 3 Head Start English course.

During the Text Analysis Lectures:

- You will **explore & analyse** the dynamics & complexities of your text including characters' traits & motivations, themes, concerns, conflicts & tensions in relationships, the complexities of plot & the function & impact of settings.
- You will study the role of **point of view** & investigate & analyse **authorial intent** so you can understand & appreciate the writer's organisational & stylistic choices, the intended effect of those choices, & what messages the author is trying to convey.
- You will explore the **historical context** and the **social & cultural values** of your text & analyse how these elements influence the way a text is read or viewed, is understood by different audiences, & how it **positions readers** in different ways.
- You will investigate how the different features of your text **create meaning & influence interpretation** & examine the explicit & implied ideas, concerns & values being conveyed.
- You will participate in detailed analyses of **key passages** from your text.
- You will learn how to **look beyond** the literal meaning of words to **find significance** & unstated meanings.
- You will learn how to **confidently** use the **relevant metalanguage** to support your analyses.
- You will learn **higher level analytical strategies** & techniques to use when **unpacking & responding** to the different essay prompts that are likely to appear in your SACs & the VCE English exam.
- You will study examples of **sophisticated essay** responses that demonstrate strong analytical skills, insightful perception & a **deep conceptual understanding** of the chosen text.
- You will discover the specific elements that differentiate **A, B & C** grade analytical text responses.
- You will apply the knowledge & skills acquired during this lecture, as well as the Area of Study 1 lectures, as you plan & construct short analytical responses to select passages, & separately, as you **analyse & mark** sample introductions, body paragraphs & conclusions of varying standards.

Detailed & comprehensive **A+ notes**, practice essay prompts, sample essay plans as well as a selection of **authentic A+** analytical text responses will be provided.

**Students will be separated into groups so they can benefit from instruction that is specific to the text they are studying at school.**

## Unit 3 Prerequisite Lectures

As the marks received in Unit 1 and 2 **don't directly** contribute to an ATAR, many students dedicate the **minimum amount of time (and effort)** to study, **incorrect in their belief** there will be plenty of opportunities to catch up in Year 12, if required. Students who start their Unit 3 studies lacking strong foundations in key Year 11 concepts **will find it difficult to cope** with new course materials, and will obtain lower SAC marks and subject ranks than otherwise possible.

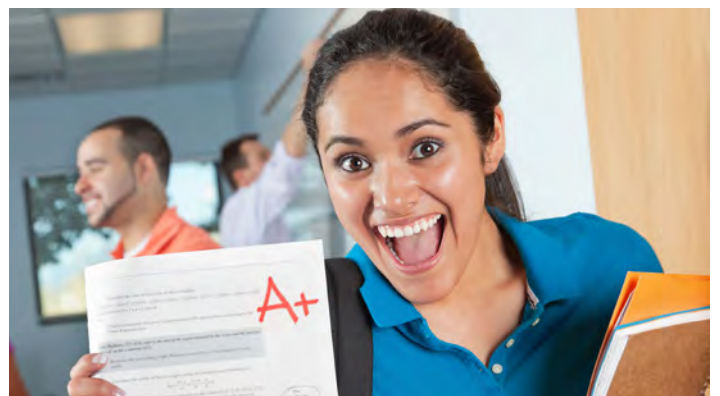
